Terms and Condition: -

Eligibility Criteria :

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The bidder must fulfil the following eligibility criteria and should submit the following documents :

- The bidder should fulfil the criteria of satisfactory execution of at least 1 similar type of work within 1. the last 3 years and should submit the work experience certificate.
- The bidders should submit the related document in support of the above works issued by 2. respective departments.
- The bidders should submit copies of valid PAN Card and GST Registration Certificate.
- 3. The rates for the above work shall be valid for one year and during this period, the work will be 4. carried out as per the need basis or as per the direction of the institute authorities.
- Before tendering, the bidder shall inspect the site to fully acquaint himself.
- 5. Payments shall be made based on the satisfactory actual work done and based on the actual measurement, after deduction of 5%, which shall be kept as security to cover the defects liability 6. for a period of six month from the date of completion. During this period, any defect is found the same shall be got rectified immediately by the successful bidder. No extra payment will be made.
- The works shall be strictly carried out as per the latest CPWD specification of work and works 8. manual under the supervision of Engineer (Civil), ISI, Delhi Centre.
- The ISI Delhi Centre reserves the right to reject the tender process at any stage without assigning 9. any reason.
- The quoted rates shall be inclusive of all taxes and charges as applicable.
- Any loss/ damaged/ theft caused to the public property/ ISI Delhi Centre / manpower engaged 10. 11. shall be sole responsibility of the agency.
- The contractor shall be responsible for their good character, all damaged done to the existing 12. structure shall be made good by the contractor at his own risk and cost.
- ISI Delhi Centre shall not be responsible for any injury of loss any worker of the contractor that 13. may take place while on work. Any compensation or expenditure towards treatment for such injury or loss of the life shall be the sole responsibility of the contractor. The contractor is solely responsible for any damage or injury or accident that may occur to any of his personnel working under his contract. No claim whatsoever arises to ISI Delhi Centre.
- After finishing of work, Malba will be removed by the contractor at his own cost. No additional 14. payment will be made in this regard.

- ISI Delhi Centre reserves the right to accept or reject any or all tenders in part or full without 16. assigning any reason thereof.

- If any incomplete of paper is found in the tender document, the tender document may be 18. summarily rejected.

TERMS OF PAYMENT 19.

Payment will be released to the contractor on successful completion of work. No advance payment/running bill will be made to the contractor under any circumstances.

20. RATES

Rates should be quoted as item wise rate basis in the enclosed Performa as per Annexure I attached with the Tender document. For those DSR items which are not covered within the scope of the Tender/BOQ, the rates should be as per current DSR rates. All rates should be inclusive of GST. Rates will remain fixed during the currency of the contract, even if there is a variation in the Cost Index.

21. STATUTORY DEDUCTIONS

All the statutory deductions towards GST / Income Tax etc. shall be made from the bill/s as applicable as per the prevailing rates under the rules. TDS as applicable will be deducted from each bill of the contractor under the statutory rules of the Union Govt., in respect of Income Tax and other taxes. No claim on account of sales tax or any other statutory taxes/ charges for execution of work awarded under this contract will be entertained by ISID and such taxes and charges should be paid by the contractor himself.

22. JURISDICTION

The legal jurisdiction of the contract shall be the High Court of Delhi only.

23. The successful bidder should be complete the work within 25 days of issuance of Work Order, failing which ISI shall recover the Compensation for Delay of work @ 1 % per month of delay to be computed on per day basis of the Tendered Value of work/total amount of bill.
