Abstract:

Discrimination in contests can take two forms: structural discrimination that affects the effectiveness of the contestants' efforts and direct discrimination that takes the form of differential taxation of the contested "prize". These two forms of discrimination can be applied by the contest designer. My objective is to compare the effectiveness of these two forms of discrimination in terms of their effect on the contestants' efforts.
